

Plug-in Day Lansing Road Rally Rules

1. Cheaters will be disqualified.
2. Participants must follow all local, state, and federal laws. This includes following the speed limit and parking ordinances.
3. There must be a seatbelt for each passenger in each vehicle.
4. Each driver must maintain a valid driver's license and automobile liability insurance that complies with the requirements of the Michigan No-Fault law while participating in the Plug-in Day Lansing Road Rally. The valid driver's license and proof of insurance must be maintained on the driver at all times and available for inspection at any time.
5. Each participant is responsible for his/her own behavior. Drivers are responsible for the behavior of riders while in their vehicles. Participants must be courteous to all volunteers, employees, patrons, and others at each stop. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the event.
6. If, in the opinion of GLACC, its members, sponsors, and partners, an action taken by a Plug-in Day Road Rally team or its members during the Road Rally is determined to be detrimental to GLACC, its members, sponsors, and partners, such as lewd and lascivious behavior, that team will be disqualified.
7. Registered teams hereby authorize photos to be taken of individuals on the team and utilized by the organizing entities and media.
8. Vandalizing locations or rally materials/equipment will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the rally and future rallies, and may result in criminal charges filed.
9. By participating as a registered team, each team member understands the risk associated with operating a motor vehicle while participating in the Plug-in Day Lansing Road Rally. Each team member assumes all associated risk and agrees to follow the rules set forth.
10. Participants hold harmless GLACC, its members, sponsors, and partners, which include but is not limited to the Lansing Board of Water & Light, from any and all damages, claims and losses, which includes but is not limited to bodily injury and/or death resulting from participation in the Plug-in Day Lansing Road Rally.
